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5. CURRICULUM

a. Community College and Career Access Pathways Partnership Agreement

It was recommended the Board approve the Community College and Career Access Pathways Partnership Agreement between Calaveras Unified School District and the San Joaquin Delta Community College District to establish a College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP) partnership that provides clear pathways for CUSD high school students to enroll in college and career courses which earn college credit while enrolled in high school.

Dr. Matt Wetstein, Assistant Superintendent and Vice President of Instruction, at San Joaquin Delta Community College, addressed the Board regarding the Career Access Pathways Partnership Agreement. This would allow concurrent enrollment for our high school students in community college courses that would be offered after school at Calaveras High School. These courses would be free of charge, except for the cost of books. These courses would be closed to the public and only offered to Calaveras High

School students. San Joaquin Delta College collects the apportionment, which allows them to cover the tuition. There is no cost to CUSD. They will also be looking for instructors, and if any of our instructors have the right qualification, they would give them first consideration. High School students would earn college credits. The classes offered would be general education courses, which could be transferred to a CSU. They will also consider offering vocational education courses.
